

Scholarship Recipient's Requirements

- A grantee's good standing in the particular college or university shall be ascertained each year. A copy of each semester's grades is required to be sent to the Scholarship Committee.
- A student must maintain a 2.0 or C average for each year in order to be considered for the following year.
- High standards of personal conduct and responsible judgment must be followed.
- It is expected that recipients of scholarships render a positive contribution to the college community and to the extent possible, to First Presbyterian Church of Gastonia. A contribution can be made through evidence of leadership and/or potential, effective participation in the regular organizations and activities of the college or university, or First Presbyterian Church of Gastonia.

The Scholarship Committee may revoke a scholarship at any time or not renew a scholarship if a student does not meet the expectations outlined above.

ALL NEW AND RENEWAL APPLICATIONS SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE, FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF GASTONIA, NORTH CAROLINA BY THE DEADLINE PUBLICIZED EACH YEAR FOR THE FOLLOWING FALL SEMESTER. IF YOU WISH TO CONTINUE YOUR SCHOLARSHIP, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO REQUEST AND COMPLETE THE RENEWAL APPLICATION AS WELL AS RETURN THE APPLICATION TO THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE PRIOR TO THE AFREMENTINOED DEADLINE.

- All recipients are required to send a letter of acknowledgement to the Scholarship Committee and in addition, a progress report before December 31st.
